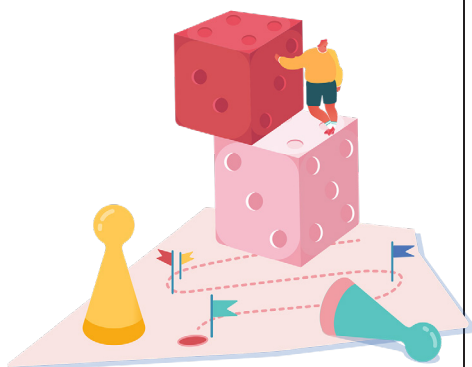

How can you use what you’ve been given?

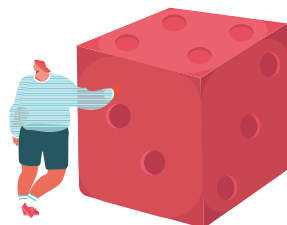


Do This
