



Basic Truth: Jesus wants to be my friend forever.

Key Question: Who is alive?

Bottom Line: Jesus is alive.

Memory Verse: “I am alive for ever and ever!” Revelation 1:18

Bible Story Focus: Jesus wants me to tell others He is alive!

Great Commission- Matthew 28:19-20

Loud and Soft: Memory Verse Activity:

What You Need: No supplies needed

What You Do:

During the Activity: Invite the children to say the Memory Verse in a soft voice and then a loud voice. Repeat several times as interest allows.

What You Say:

Before the Activity: “There are different ways that we can tell others **[Bottom Line] Jesus is alive.**”

During the Activity: “Let’s say our Memory Verse in different ways, too. First, let’s say our Memory Verse in a soft voice. (*Say the verse in a whisper.*) Nice job! Now let’s say the Memory Verse in LOUD voice! (*Shout the verse.*) (*Repeat.*) We can tell everyone that **[Bottom Line] Jesus is alive!**”

After the Activity: “Awesome! We can tell people that **[Bottom Line] Jesus is alive** in so many ways! The most important thing is that we tell EVERYONE that **[Bottom Line] Jesus is alive! Who is alive? [Bottom Line] Jesus is alive!**”

Let’s Make a Megaphone:

What You Need: Paper, markers, crayons, stickers, tape

What You Do:

During the Activity: Let’s make a megaphone. We can use it to tell everyone that **[Bottom Line] Jesus is alive!**

What You Say:

Before the Activity: “Our Bible story today told us that we should tell everyone that **[Bottom Line] Jesus is alive!**”

After the Activity: “Jesus gave His friends a very important job in our Bible story today. He wanted them to tell everyone that He is alive. He wants us to tell everyone, too! Let’s use our fun megaphones to tell everyone that **[Bottom Line] Jesus is alive! Who is alive? [Bottom Line] Jesus is alive!**”



Parachute Fun:

What You Need: A parachute, towel, blanket, or sheet. *Bonus:* Pom poms or cotton balls for added fun.

What You Do:

Before the Activity: Lay the parachute flat on the floor. Add cotton balls or pom poms if you wish.

During the Activity: Ask your kiddos to stand around the parachute with you and invite them to each pick up a section of the parachute. Invite them to hold the parachute down low, say, “Jesus,” and then raise the parachute high and say, “is alive.” Repeat several times.

What You Say:

Before the Activity: **[Bottom Line] “Jesus is alive!”**

During the Activity: “Let’s play with the parachute and tell everyone that **[Bottom Line] Jesus is alive.** Hold the parachute low and say, ‘Jesus,’ and then hold the parachute up high and say, ‘IS ALIVE!’”
(Demonstrate and do activity several times.)

After the Activity: “Awesome job! **[Bottom Line] Jesus is alive!** We can tell everyone! **Who is alive?**
[Bottom Line] Jesus is alive!”

Prayer Time:

“Dear God, thank You for giving us a special job. Help us tell everyone that **[Bottom Line] Jesus is alive** so they can be friends with Jesus forever, too. We love You, God. In Jesus’ name, amen.”
