Focus:

Memory Verse with Motions:

Before the Activity: Say the memory verse and do the motions in front of the children.

I am (point thumbs to chest) fearfully (right arm muscle) and wonderfully (left arm muscle) made, (clap hands together) Psalm 139:14 (hold hands open like a book).

During the Activity: Say the verse again with the motions, and invite the children to do it with you. Repeat several times.

Before the Activity: “I’m going to say our new memory verse. Everyone, watch me! *I am (point thumbs to chest) fearfully (right arm muscle) and wonderfully (left arm muscle) made, (clap hands together) Psalm 139:14 (hold hands open like a book).*”

During the Activity: “Now, let’s do it together! Are you ready? *I am (point thumbs to chest) fearfully (right arm muscle) and wonderfully (left arm muscle) made, (clap hands together) Psalm 139:14 (hold hands open like a book).*”

After the Activity: “Our memory verse tells us that God made us. We are fearfully and wonderfully made! **Who made you? [Bottom Line] God made me!**”

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Focus:

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Book:

What You Need: Multiple sheets of paper, crayons

What You Do:

Before the Activity: Fold the sheets of paper to make a book with 4 pages.

During the Activity: Help your preschooler draw pictures, one on each page, to retell the Bible story. [Suggested pictures: a gift, the world, a person, a heart.]

What You Say:

Before the Activity: “We’re going to make a book about our Bible story today. You can use it to remember that God made us and He loves us so much that He gave us Jesus.”

During the Activity: “Use the crayons to color the pages in the book. The book tells us the story that God made ALL of us (*point to the person*), and He LOVES (*point to heart*) us so much that He gave us an amazing GIFT (*point*). He gave everyone in the WORLD (*point*) JESUS!”

After the Activity: “Great job! **Who made you?** [**Bottom Line**] **God made me!**”
