Focus:

Memory Verse with Motions:

Before the Activity: Say the memory verse and do the motions in front of the children.

I am (point thumbs to chest) fearfully (right arm muscle) and wonderfully (left arm muscle) made, (clap hands together) Psalm 139:14 (hold hands open like a book).

During the Activity: Say the verse again with the motions, and invite the children to do it with you. Repeat several times.

Before the Activity: “I’m going to say our new memory verse. Everyone, watch me! *I am (point thumbs to chest) fearfully (right arm muscle) and wonderfully (left arm muscle) made, (clap hands together) Psalm 139:14 (hold hands open like a book).*”

During the Activity: “Now, let’s do it together! Are you ready? *I am (point thumbs to chest) fearfully (right arm muscle) and wonderfully (left arm muscle) made, (clap hands together) Psalm 139:14 (hold hands open like a book).*”

After the Activity: “Our memory verse tells us that God made us. We are fearfully and wonderfully made! **Who made you? [Bottom Line] God made me!**”

Bible Story

Focus:

I can pray to
God.

Anytime, Anywhere, Anything:

What You Need: Plain paper and crayons/markers.

What You Do:

After the Activity: Talk about how you can talk to God anywhere, anytime, about anything.

What You Say:

During the Activity: “The Bible teaches us that we can talk to God anytime, anywhere, and about anything! Can we talk to God when we wake up in the morning? *(Pause.)* Yes! We can talk to God anytime. Can we talk to God . . . at night before we go to bed? *(Pause.)* Yes! We can talk to God anytime. Day time, nighttime, bath time, nap time, ANY TIME!

“And, do you know what we can talk to God about? *(Pause.)* ANYTHING! Can you talk to God and tell Him you’re scared when there’s a storm outside? *(Pause.)* Yes! We can talk to God about anything. Can you tell God you’re sad when your friends aren’t being nice? *(Pause.)* Yes! We can talk to God about anything. You can always tell God when you’re sad. What about when you’re happy because it’s your birthday, and you’re getting presents? Can you tell God all about it? *(Pause.)* Yes! We can talk to God about anything.”

“Let’s draw some pictures that help us know we can talk to God anytime, anywhere, and about anything. I love that we can talk to God anytime, anywhere, about anything! And, God hears us! When can you talk to God? *(Pause.)* Anytime, anywhere, about anything.”
