Memory Verse with Motions:

What You Need: No supplies needed

What You Say:

Before the Activity: I love our May memory verse!

What You Say:

Before the Activity: "We talked about a special gift in our Bible story today. Do you remember what that gift is?"

During the Activity: "Let's wrap gifts together! We can use this paper and these beautiful bows!" (Do activity.)

After the Activity: "Beautiful gifts! Today, we heard a story about how much God loves us. God loves us so much He gave us Jesus! He's the best gift! Who loves me? [Bottom Line] God loves me!"
