THE BUDGET PROCESS

- 1. Set next year's ministry strategy through prayer and discernment.
- 2. Determine goals and needed resources to reach these strategies.
- 3. Forecast giving for the current and upcoming year.
- 4. Start at \$0 and build a budget for ministry needs.
- 5. Ensure 2022-23 strategies are funded.
- 6. Present 2022-23 budget to the Board of Directors and the Finance Team for review.
- 7. Make revisions if needed and present a final version of the budget to the Board and Finance Team for approval.

WHY DO WE GIVE?

Everything we have comes from God. When we give back to God through tithes and offerings, it is an act of worship and spiritual discipline. It is our stewardship and responsibility to make wise decisions with what has been entrusted to us and to use our resources in a way that glorifies God and grows His Kingdom. We invest in the things we value – our family, our home, etc. – and where we spend our time, talents, and treasures is a direct reflection of our heart.

WHEN SHOULD WE GIVE?

When we develop a consistent pattern of giving, we are regularly reminded of God's faithfulness in our life and our dependence on Him. Whatever the frequency (weekly, bi-weekly, or monthly) or vehicle (recurring gift, check in the offering basket, or mailed in) let that moment be an act of worship as you trust God with vour finances.

WHAT SHOULD WE GIVE?

We have two terms that we use when it comes to giving – tithes and offerings. We refer to the "tithe" as 10% of our income. We get this from the Old Testament (Leviticus 27:30; Malachi 3:10). While the tithe remains a good model for faithful believers, Jesus set the standard for giving when He gave everything at the cross. It's the single greatest gift ever made, and as we strive to model Christ, our generosity should increase as well. While a tithe is the starting point for giving generously, there are times in the life of the church when gifts above the tithe are given. We call these offerings, and they meet the needs of designated initiatives, such as capital campaigns and special one-time initiatives.

WHAT DOES THE BIBLE SAY ABOUT GIVING?

"Remember this: The person who sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and the person who sows generously will also reap generously. Each person should do as he has decided in his heart—not reluctantly or out of necessity, for God loves a cheerful giver." - 2 Corinthians 9:6-7

But when you give to the poor, don't let your left hand know what your right hand is doing, so that your giving may be in secret. And vour Father who sees in secret will reward vou. - Matthew 6:3-4

Though we look forward to the day the Lord provides a permanent home, we celebrate the doors our relationship with Riverside Elementary has opened to reach hundreds of teachers and students with the love of Christ and establish a presence in both the Riverside and downtown communities. We have seen people from all walks of life, across multiple generations build relationships and grow together with the one singular focus to make Jesus known.

It has been a great start, but it is only just beginning, and we believe the best days are ahead. We are excited to see what the Lord has in store for Rolling Hills Columbia. Excited to meet the new faces and families whom He is sending our way. Excited to be sharing the Gospel that transforms lives. Excited to be part of what our great God is doing, and overwhelmingly grateful for the prayers, support, and encouragement from our Rolling Hills family!

Jeff and Misty's teenage daughter, Lexi Kate Woodford, experienced the love of God's people at Rolling Hills. And she hasn't kept it to herself! Lexi Kate has been faithfully serving in our Kids Ministry, pouring into young kids just like our church community poured into her family. Just like her father, who served our preschoolers and their families, Lexi Kate is serving our next generation.

NEXT GENERATION – LEXI KATE WOODFORD'S STORY

PROVIDING FOR THE VULNERABLE **IN MOLDOVA**

One important aspect of JMI is our indigenous staff on the ground in the countries where we work. When the war began in Ukraine, our staff was key in how we responded so quickly to the refugee crisis. By the grace of God we have been able to distribute thousands of aid items to refugees, including everything from food and hygiene kits, to medical supplies, bedding, and mattresses. Ukrainian refugees coming into Moldova are arriving with war-related trauma, such as loss, grief, fear, anxiety, and depression. The need for short and long-term trauma support is critical, and we are working hard to develop a program that will offer this care and support.

Thousands upon thousands of Ukrainian children are refugees in Moldova. Most of these children have lost homes, possessions, and in some cases, family members, due to this war. We have been able to host child-friendly spaces, similar to a Vacation Bible School, for children to play and have fun, do crafts, learn about Jesus, receive gifts, and enjoy food and snacks. As we continue to develop more curriculum for refugee children, our Transitional Living teenagers are coming alongside our staff and helping implement these day camps in addition to supporting our Vulnerable Child Sponsorship Programs.

As we watch our Transitional Living teens grow into these wonderful leaders, we are seeing the positive impact of our sponsorship programs come to fruition. Not only are we reaching individuals through these programs, but we are seeing a community and Kingdom impact that will continue into eternity.

REACHING THE UNREACHED IN THE AMAZON

This year, we returned to the Amazon for our first Jungle Pastors' Conference since 2020. What a precious reunion it was! After two years of not having our annual conferences, it was a tremendous blessing getting to spend face to face time with our pastors and their wives.

Over the years through these Jungle Pastors' Conferences, we have built an incredible network of pastors and local indigenous churches. Last year our pastors started to express their desire to take their church members on mission trips deeper into unreached areas of the Amazon. Research has shown that 80% of the state of Amazonas still has no Gospel presence. Our jungle pastors have the heart and the willingness to travel even further into the jungle, to places where we simply cannot go.

Instead of selling our legacy boat, The Discovery, we repurposed it to provide a boat for indigenous, local churches to use for mission trips throughout the Amazon region. At the end of last year we launched our Jungle Church on Mission program and to date we have sent out four jungle church mission trips armed with the Good News of the Gospel. God continues to expand our mission and ministry in the Amazon and He is using these faithful men and women to reach the ends of the Earth.

- Host community events at our Franklin, Nashville, Nolensville, and Columbia Campuses that welcome new people into our building and provide an opportunity to connect outside of Sunday mornings.
- Continue praying and searching for what area God may be calling us to as we look to open additional campuses in the coming years.
- Provide the required resources in this area including staff, programming supplies, facility costs, and other administrative support.

ONLINE CAMPUS

We believe we are called to use all avenues to share the Good News of Jesus Christ. That's why, in addition to our four physical locations, we have an Online Campus which is broadcasted from our Franklin Campus on Sunday mornings. And, over the past few years, God has been moving in BIG ways in this community!

Since 2020, improving our virtual experience of worship and teaching each Sunday has remained a top priority; however, over the past year, we've begun to leverage the online space to build even more community among those in our Online Campus — a community that goes beyond Sunday mornings, and includes virtual Bible studies, serving opportunities, and more.

Just this past year...

- We've had over 20 Online Campus attendees take a Next Step in serving at Rolling Hills.
- We launched our first-ever Women's Online Bible Study.
- We've had women from 10 different states be a part of our Facebook Group and Zoom Groups within our Online Bible Study.
- We have people tune in to our Online Campus community from all over the U.S. 48 states and even the world each week, and we average around 700 people any given Sunday morning.

We have been blessed to see much growth in our Online Campus community this year and can't wait to see how God continues to provide digital discipleship and community-building opportunities for us!

God's story for the Nashville Campus of Rolling Hills is too big to confine to one continent alone! Years ago, Raymond and Gigi Kinzounza were refugees during the Civil War in Congo. They felt afraid, tired, and alone. And they praved without ceasing – asking God to bring them to a place of safety and security.

Miraculously, a door opened up for them to flee to the United States of America. When the Kinzounzas ended up in the city of Nashville, TN, one of their top priorities was finding a church to call home. Again, they praved, faithfully and obediently, for guidance and direction and a church family – and, while walking down the street, they saw Park Avenue Baptist Church, the church that would later merge with Rolling Hills to become our Nashville Campus. They knew this was where God was calling them to be.

After years of being invested in and serving at their new church home, they have seen God move in the life of our church in amazing ways. Today, the Kinzounza's lead Community Groups, serve on our A6 and C3 Servant Leadership Teams, and greet visitors on Sunday mornings as part of our Welcome Team.

We are thankful to be a part of the Kinzounza's story – and we, too, like Raymond and Gigi, are in awe of what our good God can do. God took a couple of refugees half a world away and brought them into His work here in Middle Tennessee. Let's always remember to consider how blessed we are to have the opportunity to freely and openly share our faith and serve a church in Jesus' name.
